

**Young Researchers Poster Exhibit Contest  
August 12-14, 2009**

**MECHANICS FOR POSTER PRESENTATION**

**EXHIBIT GUIDELINES:**

**1. CONTENT**

- The poster should include the following identifying information:
  - Name or title of research or project
  - Complete institution or author address
  - Telephone or contact numbers or email
- It should give a brief description of the research in layman’s simple language
- It should cite reasons why such project was developed or why the study was conducted. It should state its potential benefits in terms of its impact on health and quality of life, its science or technology contributions or its socio-economic benefits.
- The poster should exhibit the highlight of the study in not smaller than 16” x 20” picture or colored presentation which may be in the form of study framework, end product or outcome of the project, stakeholders’ participation, and the like.
- Graphical and other appropriate presentations may also be included.

**2. FORM**

- One poster panel will be allowed per entry.
- Poster size should be 2 feet width by 4 feet height. Use of illustration board is recommended.

**3. MOUNTING MATERIALS**

- Participants are expected to bring their own adhesives and other mounting materials to ensure that the posters stay in place during the duration of the exhibit.
