eHealth.Ph - an internet-linked community where people can interact with each other on specific health issues and topics, and at the same time have access to the specialty database, journal articles, advisories and directory-typed information

eHealth TABLET -Mobile-based patient medical record system equipped with a visualization tool of local patient data and a mayor-doctor communication sub-system. Pilot sites: Paombong Bulacan; Sta. Rita Pampanga ; Guimba, Nueva Ecija; Basco, Batanes; Anilao, Iloilo; San Jose de Buenavista, Antique; Alcoy, Cebu; Dumalinao, Zamboanga Del Sur; *Veruela, Agusan Del Sur* and Isulan Sultan Kudarat

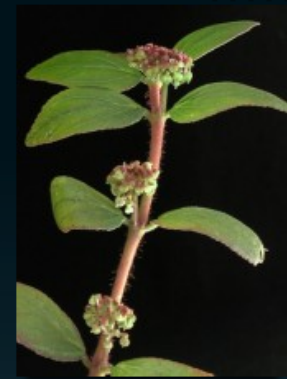

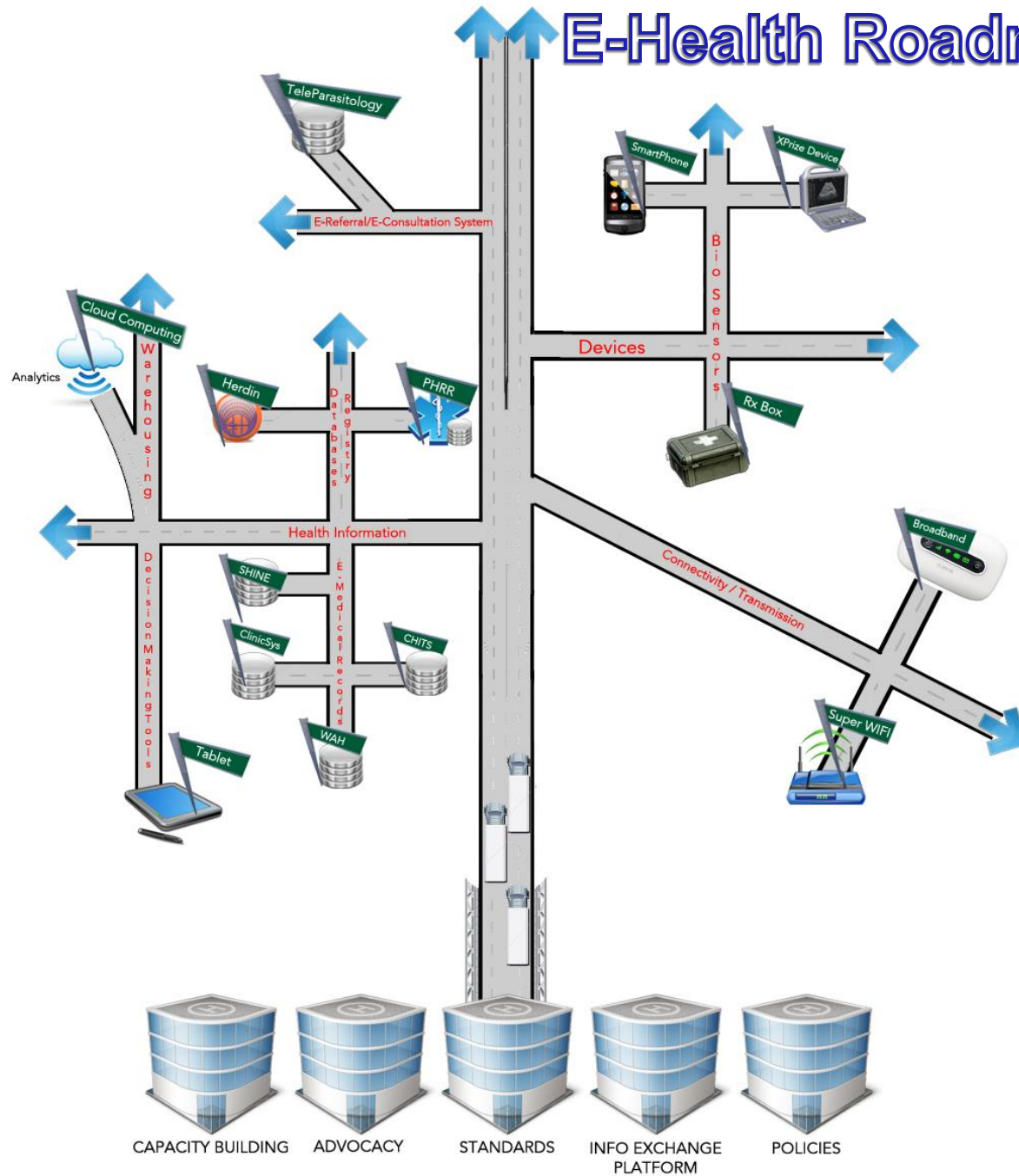
