CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

An applicant must:

- belong to any of the following:
 - ⇒ professionals doing research or those from industry
 - ⇒ newly graduated students
 - ⇒ on-going MS/PhD students in priority S&T fields and DOST network schools
- be a Filipino citizen;
- not be more than 45 years old at the time of application;
- be in good health condition;
- have passed the admission requirements for graduate studies at any of the DOST identified institutions; and
- have passed the interview and other screening procedures.

 - University Evaluation Sheet for Admission in the graduate program signed by the Dean of Graduate Studies/School
 - Program of study approved by the graduate school*

INCENTIVE

The remaining stipends shall be given to those who completed their degrees earlier than the prescribed period of study.

TERMS OF THE GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- 1. The scholarship award shall be for full-time graduate studies for the completion of an MS/PhD degree in any of the DOST identified priority fields.
- 2. Awardees shall execute a Scholarship Agreement with DOST.
- 3. Evaluation of the academic performance of the scholar based on established policies shall be done to determine the scholarship status every semester or term.
- 4. A service obligation to be rendered in the Philippines shall be required of the scholars after finishing the MS/PhD degree, i.e. one year for every year of scholarship.
- 5. Refund of scholarship grant with interest for non-completion of the graduate program and failure to comply with the service obligation.
