This we offer as long as you are a staff member or faculty, holding or being considered for a permanent position in an institution engaged in health research activities, and if you have not enjoyed any scholarship grant from our office.

Your request for financial assistance will be considered if you meet the following requirements:

- You are pursuing an **MS or PhD program** in one of the following fields: *biochemistry, biostatistics, chemistry, epidemiology, immunology, microbiology, molecular biology and biotechnology, pharmacology, pharmacy, health economics, and health social science.*
- Your thesis proposal compiles with the following criteria:
 - the extent to which your proposal meets the priorities in the National Health Research and Development Plan (NHRDP)
 - its potential significance in terms of implications and practice in health research
 - its technical feasibility, and
 - its reasonableness in budget

You can receive as much as **PHP100,000** for a master's thesis project, and **PHP200,000** for a doctoral dissertation.

REQUIREMENTS

It's easy to apply. Simply submit the following:

- *a duly accomplished application form which can be secured from our office or may be downloaded from our website*
- *a copy of your proposal*
- *a certification of the proposal's approval from your thesis panel, and*
- *a letter of endorsement from the head of your institution.*

We require applicants to submit their applications in **JANUARY** (for the first batch) and **JUNE** (for the second batch) of every calendar year.
