- Session on Sustaining Quality Health Research through Ethical Review
 - Create an organization or a national forum for health research ethics comprised of all institutional Ethics Review Committees. Create a task force to think about the organization, plans, funding, etc.
 - Come up with the 2011 revised edition of the National Ethical Guidelines on Health Research, incorporating new ethical considerations and issues resulting from changes in the landscape of health research.



Health Research Agenda

- Have a common holistic pro-poor framework to link different health research priorities
- Include new areas, research topics that would economically benefit the country as well as emerging problems that should be addressed and incorporated to the current NUHRA
- Clarify PNHRS funding for NUHRA



- Technology Transfer Act of 2009 and University Readiness
 - Encourage universities or cluster of universities to establish own technology licensing offices to move research results and creative efforts from laboratories to market
 - Incorporate provisions of Technology Transfer Act in the ongoing CHED-IP Philippines initiatives on IP development



Writing Your Research in Peer-Reviewed Journals

- Provide support (could be in terms of funding, mentoring or both) to the conduct of research
- Explore the possibility of several institutions joining together to form a journal that could be accredited under the journal accreditation system of CHED



Presentation of Regional Research Projects

- Research results of seven studies from different regions were presented
- Recommendations for further study were outlined as well as possible partnerships to translate the results into policy or innovations



- Research Repository Now: Easing access to research and expertise
 - Promote HERDIN as a portal encouraging network institutions to contribute to the regional and national repositories of heath research
 - Create a DOST-CHED Technical Working Group to harmonize initiatives and standardize data exchange formats for the research inputs of HEIs
