





## Summary

- Research areas cover a range of the NUHRA and RUHRA
- RHRDCs have diverse institutional membership
- Almost all RHRDCs have a research oversight framework in place, in the form of IRB systems
- RHRDCs present suitable opportunity for research collaboration and partnership, and systems development
- Institutions have different strengths, which can be mutually beneficial



#### Restructuring and retooling efforts in response to PNHRS-SOME assessment

- Review of RUHRA and refocusing of research efforts on top priority areas
- Preparation of research proposals addressing identified priority programs (e.g., Mindanao-wide MCH program proposal)
- Establishment of internal monitoring and activity tracking system
- Organizational adjustments (designation of permanent/alternate representatives, hiring of consortium secretariat, identification of lead institutions)
- Preparation of strategic plans



#### Next Steps (Mindanao)

- ★ Actively engage the more skilled and experienced researchers in the regions to focus research efforts on bigger-scale projects with potential to create greater health impacts → e.g., several regional institutions (MSU-IIT, UIC) are being eyed to become potential partners under PCHRD-DOST's Drug Discovery and Development program
- Foster increased collaborative efforts among and between networks to facilitate sharing of resources, information and expertise
- Secure commitment of network institutions like CHED and DOH to support R&D program proposals developed (e.g., Mindanao-wide MCH program proposal)
- Balance R&D foci to cover biomedical research, social sciences, & operations research
- Institutionalize regular reporting of health R&D projects/activities
  by member-institutions
- Institutionalize adoption of health R&D database
